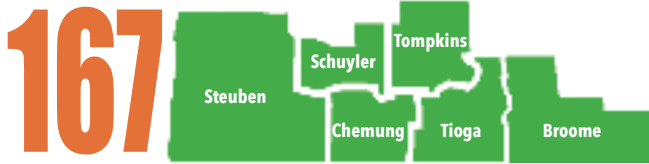

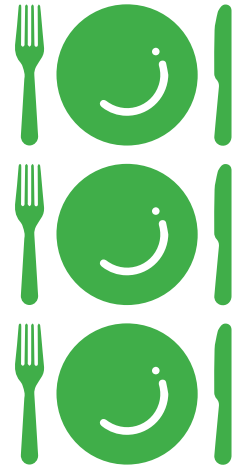


PARTNER AGENCIES ACROSS SIX COUNTIES

2015 HIGHLIGHTS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Food Distribution

The Food Bank distributed 10,089,342* pounds of food with a value of \$17,151,881 with over 1 million requests for food during the year.

*The Broome County Council of Churches CHOW Program distributed 1,334,424 lbs. of food. CHOW received 468,056 lbs. from the Food Bank of the Southern Tier.

Healthy Harvest Program

The Food Bank distributed 1,429,749 pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables to those in need through partnerships with local and national farmers.

BackPack Program™

Throughout the school year, 2,781 children at risk of hunger in 41 school districts were provided with a weekly pack of food to take home over weekends and holiday breaks.

Mobile Food Pantry Program

Mobile Food Pantry trucks distributed 3,230,042 pounds of food, including 723,129 pounds of produce, at 685 distributions, 206 at senior housing facilities.

Hunger Education and Advocacy

In 2015, 1,008 people participated in hunger education workshops and the Food Bank communicated with state and federal officials 57 times.

Food Bank Volunteers

Volunteers contributed 42,369 hours of support and repacked 1,737,866 pounds of food and grocery items for distribution to those in need.
