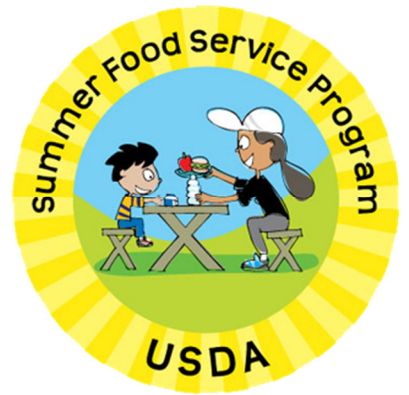

Steuben County Free Summer Meals for Kids
