

Searching for a Neighbor – No Reservations

Service Insights on Meal Connect stores information about neighbors so they can easily be served on returning visits. Each time a neighbor visits, begin by searching the system for a neighbor's profile. The search bar is located at the top of the screen.

Neighbor profiles can be found through a number of search options including: neighbor name, neighbor address, neighbor phone number, neighbor birthdate or neighbor Alternative Id (Alt. Id).

Search by Neighbor Name

You can search by:

last name only (e.g., Doe)

first SPACE last name (e.g., John Doe)

last COMMA first name (e.g., Doe, John)

You can use a partial name search. It is recommended to use the first 3-4 letters of the last name and the first 3-4 letters of the first name to account for spelling errors. If only one name is used the system will only search on last name. Searching with only first name, wildcards or the end of last names only will not return results.

Search by Neighbor Address

Search for a neighbor's street address (e.g., 5 Test Dr.). However, you cannot search by only city, state, or ZIP code.

Search by Neighbor Phone Number

Search by phone number in multiple formats:

123-123-4444

1231234444

the last 4 digits (e.g., 4444)

Search by Neighbor Birthdate

Search by birthdate in in multiple formats:

MM-DD-YYYY

MM/DD/YYYY

MM.DD.YYYY

MMDDYYYY

Search by Neighbor Alt. Id

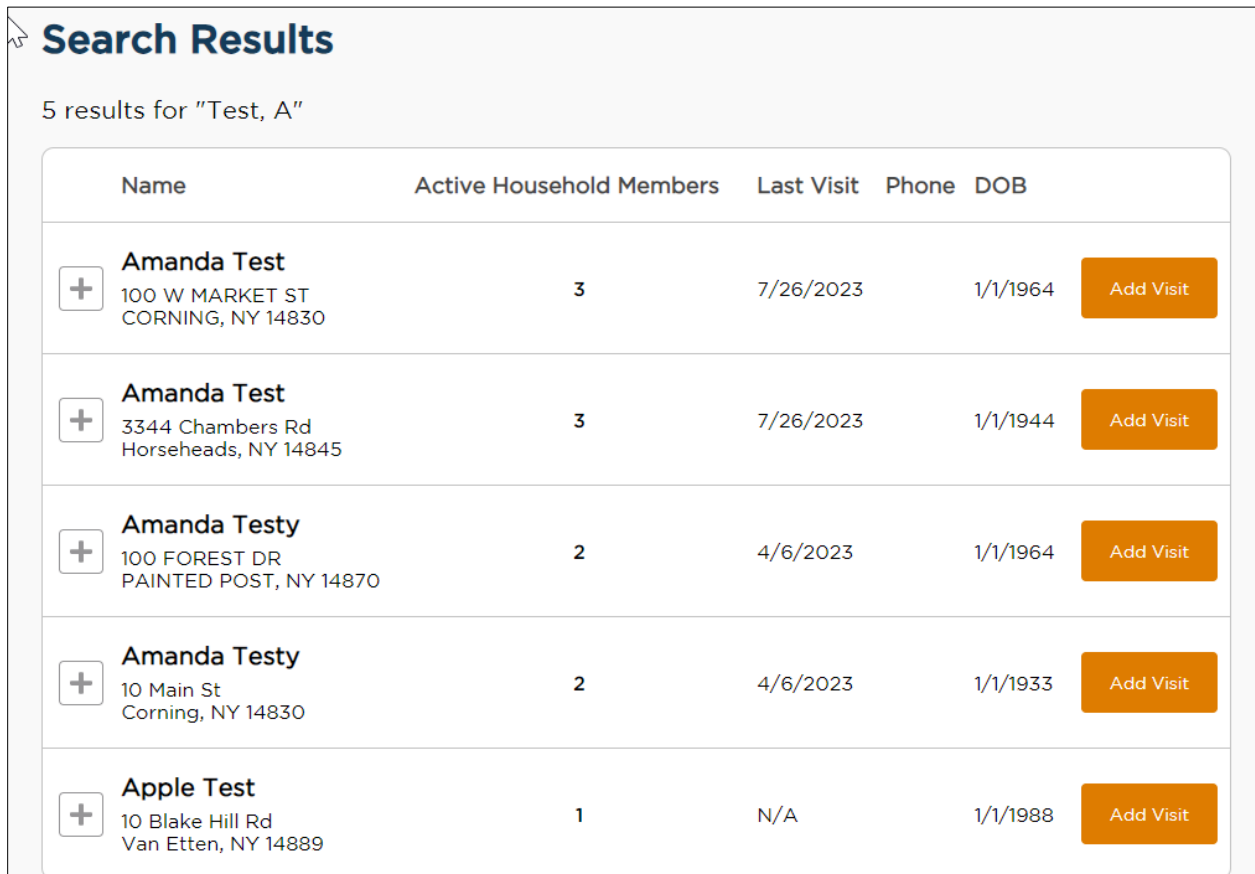
Use this for quick check-in if the returning neighbor has a barcode card or Alt. Id number. When the Alt. Id search type is selected, the barcode icon will appear on the right-hand side of the search bar. Click on the barcode icon to activate your device's camera or external barcode scanner. Scanning a barcode card will pull up the neighbor's household profile. You can also type an Alt. Id number directly into the search bar if the neighbor knows their Alt. Id number but does not have their card.

Understanding Search Results

You may confirm the person's street address and click on Add Visit. Or, you may click on the (+) sign to see more information to help determine that this is the person you want to add to the visit.

Once you click on Add Visit, a screen will pop up asking which *primary* service a person is receiving. Only one primary service may be chosen at this time. These options will differ from one pantry to another based upon which services the pantry offers. All pantries will have a Choice Pantry – 3 Day Supply option for people who meet the TEFAP eligibility guidelines and a Non-TEFAP Eligible option for those who do not qualify. This particular pantry also offers home delivery.

Note: *Secondary* or additional services may be selected at the end of the intake process and more than one secondary service may be selected.

For this example, Choice Pantry – 3 Day Supply was selected as the Primary Service.


Click next, then the system will ask if any information has changed. Updates to the Basic Information/Name, Contact, Household, SNAP Benefits, Other Government Benefits, Income, and Proxy may be made at this time. Make the appropriate updates, or if no updates need to be made, click Save and Continue.
